







Asphalt Quality Control

- Ran various test such as taking samples, wet and dry sieve analysis, and making pills








Quality Control

Grading Operations and Land Survey


- Was able to get familiar with the basic operations of grading.



- Learned the struggles or problems the drivers may face within a day






Mixer
